



Release Note / Assessment Player 2.0

We are now introducing a new, more accessible interface for students. Assessment Player 2.0 represents a foundation for new assessment types and integrations. It enables e-assessment in more subjects, with even higher precision, security and fairness.

The update happens in two steps:

Step 1 - "Say hello"

7. October 2016: Launch of Assessment Player 2.0 including all core components, but with certain limitations. Learn more further down.

Step 2 - Complete version

3. November 2016: Complete version of Assessment Player 2.0, including new features like GeoGebra and automatic submission on home exams.

- Create new demo tests with version 2.0
- Preview and compare existing question sets in old and new player

Limitations in this release

The following features will be completed during October

- Offline-detection: Although offline mode is fully supported, there are still some limitations to offline detection in SEB for MacOS
- Support for Audio Player in Internet Explorer
- Math entry and Math working: Available in PDF version
- Numeric entry: Consistent behaviour when number of decimals are not defined
- Post submission review: In the current version, the submission appears to be editable after submitting answers - which is not possible

The following features will be available 3rd November.

- Results page for candidates
- Previewing from Question Editor
- Exit SEB warnings in Monitor
- Send message to candidate(s) from Monitor
