SEB configuration updated

September 15th 2017 we updated the SEB configuration so that Chrome-based browsers (Chrome, Opera, Vivaldi and others) are shut down when starting Safe Exam Browser version 2.1.5 and newer. Students are informed prior to starting the test.

Firefox is now also automatically closed upon SEB startup.

SEB password extended to 6 characters

For safety reasons, the SEB password is changed from 4 to 6 characters, requiring both letters and numbers.

SEB password: zx3916

The new default SEB password is 2 letters and 4 numbers.

Known issues upon release

- Knowledge Base is in the process of being updated
- Selected captions are flagged for review early next week

Print and Download Manager



The new Print and Download Manager is an important update to Inspera Assessment. Now available in Deliver, Grading and Student Dashboard, it improves PDFs, printing and downloading in many ways:

- Faster PDF generation
- Improved performance for large files
- Informative and sortable file names
- Uploaded files will be renamed to match candidate ID.
- All external files included in ZIP packages (Attachments, File uploads, etc)
- Unified layout for screen, PDF and print versions
- Batch-download multiple submissions from Monitor

Known issues upon release

- ZIP filenames do not yet include Test titles.
- Missing caption in PDF cover page. Scheduled for fix during weekend.

Please note. For safety reasons, the Print and Download Manager will be activated gradually across institutions during the next few days.

Essay Temporary Backup Snapshots



The purpose of Temporary Backup Snapshot in Essays is to enable candidates and invigilators to restore lost work in the case of broken undo / redo history. The purpose is <u>not</u> to empower candidates with revision control.

Using the snapshots, candidates can roll back and restore Essay responses to an earlier version within the same active session. A new snapshot is taken every 15 minutes, and is saved in the browser memory. Restoring a snapshot will also take a new snapshot of current work, enabling candidates to roll forward to the newest version if needed.

Important. Snapshots are only saved in browser memory. Not to the server. This means:

- Snapshots are ONLY available within the same, active session:
 - o Refreshing the browser (not possible in SEB) will clear saved snapshots
 - Logging out will clear saved snapshots
- Navigating between questions will NOT clear saved snapshots

Essay Formula Editor

Using the Essay Formula Editor, candidates can add inline formulas in Essays.



Known issue upon release:

A bug in Chrome causes the focus not to be changed to the math input field when opening the Formula editor.


Essay Full Screen Mode

Using the Essay Full Screen Mode, students can expand the input area. The editor is then maximized beneath the info-header, so that remaining time and other messages are still visible.




Essay Bands and Criteria*

Using Bands and Criteria for Essay, authors can now enable graders to mark by categories / criteria (Problem solving, Mathematical models, etc) and reward marks using thresholds / bands pr. category.



Monitor Search and Filters



As the first step of unifying all lists in Inspera Assessment, we are now releasing an improved Monitor Search and Filter bar:

- · Search directly with no clicks
- Reset all filters with one click
- · Active filter count indicator
- Search within dropdowns for filters and columns


Other improvements




Randomised codes prevent sketches with single number errors to be attached to other candidates within the same test.

Inspera SEB is a Closed Source lockdown browser based on Safe Exam Browser. It improves checking forbidden processes on the candidate PC / MAC and includes candidate warnings prior to exam start. If one or more forbidden processes are running upon Inspera SEB startup, the candidate can terminate these with one click.


