

# Merging submission PDFs now optional

#### Print Manager. No activation required.

When downloading submissions as PDF, you will now have the option to download all submissions as separate PDF files, or as one, merged PDF including all submissions.



The Print Manager is essentially handling three file types when creating PDFs:

- 1. PDFs generated on demand from online submissions (Submission PDF)
- 2. PDFs uploaded by candidates and/or admin users
- 3. Other file types uploaded by candidates and/or admin users

The Print Manager handles these files in the following way:

#### Files uploaded by candidates

- PDF files uploaded by candidates through the File upload question type, are automatically merged with the submission PDF
- Other files uploaded by candidates are included in submission ZIP, but not merged with submission PDF


#### Files attached by Admin users

- PDF files uploaded by admins through Monitor are automatically merged with the submission PDF, following the last question in submission PDF
- Other files uploaded by admins through Monitor are included in submission ZIP, but not merged with submission PDF

# Improved handling of candidates using multiple browser tabs

**Assessment Player.** Applies to Open Tests (Not lockdown browsers). No activation required.

Until now, candidates in open tests (Not lockdown) could have active sessions in Inspera Assessment across multiple tabs. To prevent candidates from unintentionally submitting a wrong version of their answers, this is now blocked.



#### How it works:

- Whenever a browser window is refreshed or a test is opened from dashboard, the current tab is marked as "active" by Inspera Assessment.
- If a non-active tab then attempts to modify the submission, the modification is blocked and the candidate is notified, as illustrated above.

Demo tests are still allowing multiple tabs.

### Other improvements

- New option to allow started file uploads to complete after test closes.
  Requires activation.
- Improved handling of poor network connection during test startup and submission
- Taxonomies (beta): Filter Questions and Question Sets by Taxonomy nodes
- Grading: Fixed issue with printing comments (Annotation) in Grading
- Protocol / FS: Fixed issue with assessment combination missing from protocol
- Fixed issue where candidates would in some cases wrongly be flagged as offline
