Oral exams

Inspera Assessment now supports oral exams. The core concept is to use the grading tool for live (or delayed) assessment of oral examinations, musical performances, presentations, practical exams ++

In oral exams, candidates are not required to submit anything digitally or do any on-screen interactions whatsoever.
