- Support for transferring grades to FS for unlinked tests

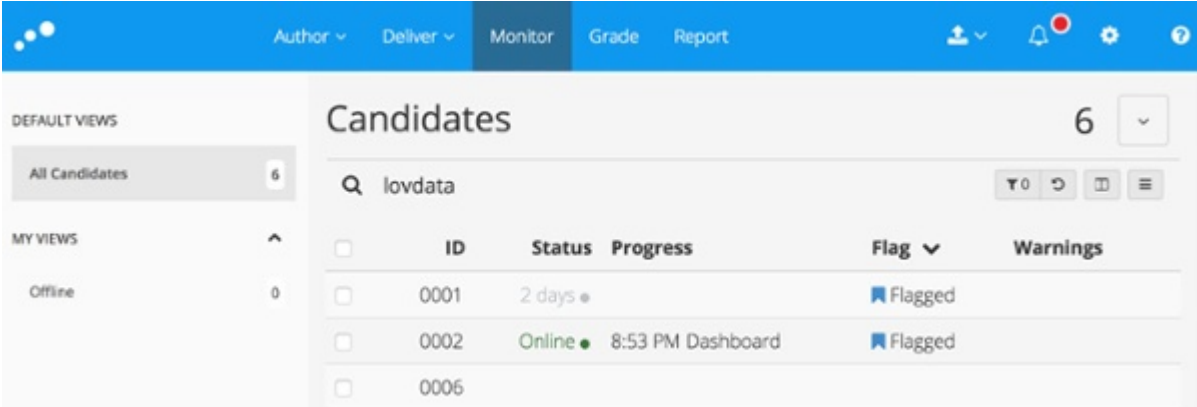

### General release

## Flagging of candidates

*No activation required*

Flagging allows Planners and (Chief) Invigilators to highlight candidates in Monitor. Flagging a candidate makes no other changes to the candidate or submission. The purpose is essentially to have a visual marker of candidates that need follow-up or other actions at a later stage.

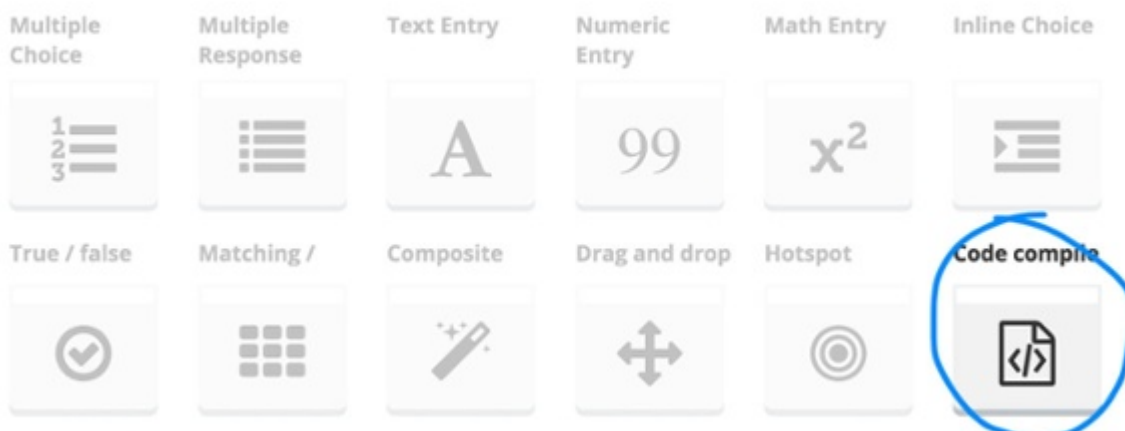

## New Question type: Code Compiler

Code Compiler is an automatically marked question type for programming.

During exams, candidates can run and compile code using sample input and output test cases. Upon submitting, the code is automatically compiled and evaluated against separate marking test cases not available to candidates during the test.

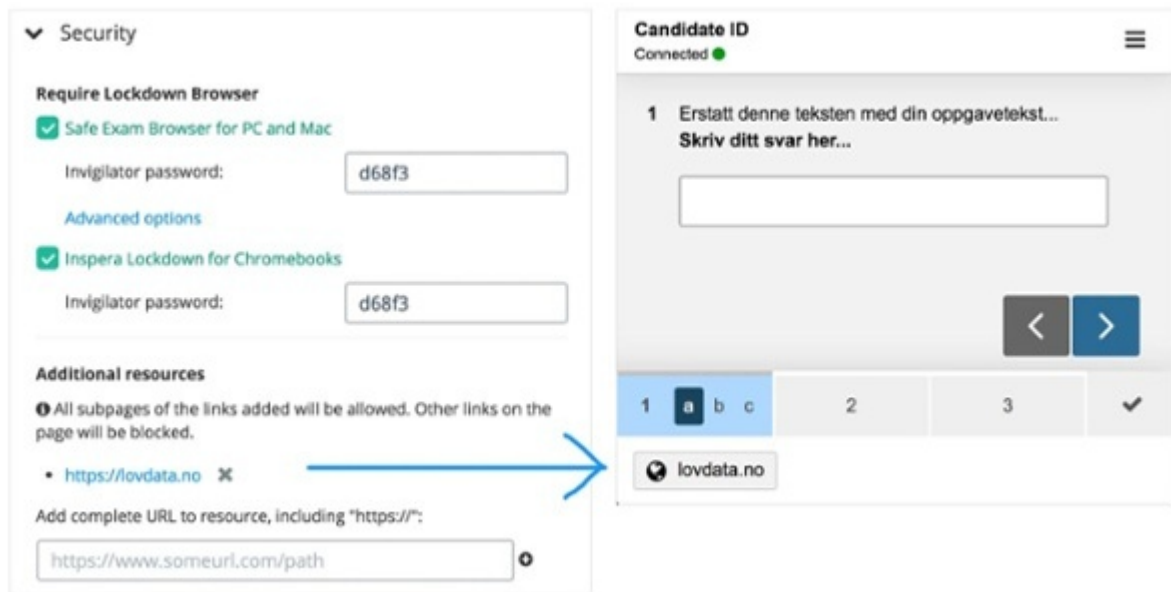

## Secure links to external web resources during exams

Requires SEB 2.2 Windows, SEB 2.1 macOS or Inspera Lockdown for Chrome OS

**Additional resources** allow Planners to specify links that can be opened from a new task bar within the locked down environment during exams. A network filter checks requests so that candidates are not able to navigate away from the page specified. All links, except links to subpages are blocked.



Multiple web resources can be added to a test.
